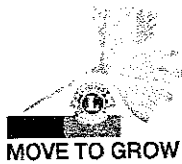
All Clubs are encouraged to bring their Club Banners for display in the grand ballroom. Lion Ken Lake will be collecting them at the hotel beginning Friday.
