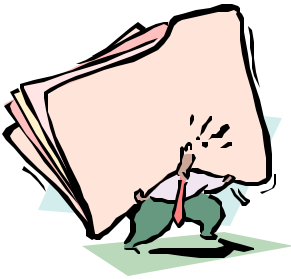


# INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY: What does it do for you?
