At the same time the program is designed to lead long time members on a path that will continue and strengthen their commitment to both the District and their individual clubs. This program cannot be completed without being actively involved in your own club's functions as well as helping out at the District level.

8. Attend White Cane Day Event		
9. Participate in a Braille Book Project
